## A BILL

*intituled*

An Act to make special provision for the grant of a pension to Tengku Ampuan Jema'ah binti Raja Ahmad, the widow of His late Majesty Sultan Hisamuddin Alam Shah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Ala'iddin Sulaiman Shah.

[1st September, 1960.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Ra'ayat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Special Pension (Tengku Ampuan Jema'ah binti Raja Ahmad) Act, 1960, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of September, 1960.

Grant of

2. There shall be granted to the Tengku Ampuan Jema'ah binti Raja Ahmad, the widow of His late Majesty Sultan Hisamuddin Alam Shah ibni Al-Marhum Sultan Ala'iddin Sulaiman Shah, a pension at the rate of one thousand dollars per month.

3. The provisions of section 12 of the Pensions Ordinance, 1951 (which relates to the non-assignability and non-attachment of pensions) shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the pension granted under this Act.

4. The pension granted under this Act shall be charged on the Consolidated Fund.

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The object of the above Bill is to provide for the payment to the Tengku Ampuan Jema'ah binti Raja Ahmad, the widow of His late Majesty Sultan Hisamuddin Alam Shah, of a pension at the rate of one thousand dollars a month.
