A BILL

An Act to amend the Employees Provident Fund Ordinance, 1951.

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Ra'ayat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Employees Provident Fund (Amendment) Act, 1960.
- 2. Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Employees Provident Fund Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by substituting for the words "and the persons so appointed shall elect one of their number" appearing therein the comma and words ", who shall appoint one of such persons".

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to empower the Minister of Finance to appoint a member of the Employees Provident Fund Board to be Chairman of the Board. At present the Chairman is elected by members of the Board.
