An Ordinance to make provision for the public service
for the year 1950.

[1st January, 1950.]

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED by the High Commissioner of the Federation of Malaya and Their Highnesses the Rulers of the Malay States with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supply (1950) Ordinance, 1949, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1950.

2. A sum not exceeding two hundred and fifty-eight million, fifty-three thousand, nine hundred and eighty-five dollars shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenues and other funds of the Federation of Malaya for the service of the year 1950; and the said sum may be expended as specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
